**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE FOLLOWING APPLICATIONS FOR WATER WELL DRILLING PERMIT and WATER WELL OPERATING PERMIT:**

Williams O & G Address: 9029 4<sup>th</sup> Street NW Albuquerque, NM 87114

Filed with the Reeves County Groundwater Conservation District (District) an application for permits to **DRILL and OPERATE** water wells to produce **200 gallons per minute (GPM)** per well (**1,680 max allotted-acre feet/year**) to be used for **Fracking and Oil & Gas Rig Supply**. Three wells will draw from the **Pecos Valley aquifer** at a depth of **550 feet**, and one well will reach **1,500 feet** into the **Rustler aquifer**. The proposed wells are located on **280 contiguous acres**, approximately 2.5 miles northeast of FM 1450 and CR 104 in Reeves County, Texas. The wells are identified as follows:

**AB 5842 BLK C-4 SEC 16PSL OUT E/2**

**Three wells - Proposed depth of 550 feet into the Pecos Valley aquifer:**

- **RC3431 – Coordinates: Latitude 31.3449, Longitude -103.22419**
- **RC3433 – Coordinates: Latitude 31.352389, Longitude -103.221789**
- **RC3434 – Coordinates: Latitude 31.344983, Longitude -103.21206**

**One well - Proposed depth of 1,500 feet into the Rustler aquifer:**

- **RC3432 – Coordinates: Latitude 31.345506, Longitude -103.216782**

The Board of Directors will conduct a hearing on the proposed permits on Friday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025, at 5:00pm. The Board of Directors may deny or grant in full or in part a permit application and issue a permit for any amount less than or equal to the amount requested in the application.
