NOTICE OF HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD ON PROPOSED DESIRED
FUTURE CONDITIONS
July 23, 2026

The Board of Directors of the Reeves County Groundwater Conservation District (RCGCD) will conduct a hearing and take public comment on proposed desired future conditions (DFCs) for the Edwards-Trinity (Plateau and Pecos Valley)), Capitan Reef Complex, Dockum and Rustler aquifers underlying portions of Reeves County within RCGCD. The hearing will be held at 5:00 p.m. on July 23, 2026 at 119 South Cedar Street, Pecos, Texas 79772. A quorum of Board may be present in person at the physical location or may participate via audio conference call. Likewise, members of the public may participate in person at the physical location or via audio conference call. The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Texas Government Code, Sections 551.125, 551.127 and 551.131.

This hearing will be recorded and the recording will be available on the District's website www.reevescountygcd.org after the meeting.

The RCGCD and Middle Pecos Groundwater Conservation District are the two districts located within Groundwater Management Area 3 (GMA 3).

The DFCs as were approved by GMA 3 on April 23, 2026. The proposed DFCs are as follows:
